WHAT IS IT?

A kenalog injection is a steroid used to help soften and smooth your hypertrophic (thick and/or raised) burn scar. Injections are typically required over multiple visits.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Kenalog injections may cause itching at the injection site. If itching occurs, you may use over-the-counter oral medication.



Use antibiotic ointment on the injection site as directed. Use 2-3 times daily for 2-3 days. If you are wearing pressure garments, use ointment and a non-stick pad, such as a Telfa pad, under your garments. You may resume wearing your compression garments 24 hours after the injections.







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
