### WHAT IS IT?

PermeaDerm is a temporary wound covering intended to provide a moist healing environment for your wound. At your first dressing change, it should look like the photo to the right. It should gradually dry and stick to the burn over the next one to two weeks. You can trim the PermeaDerm as it separates from the burn.

### WHAT TO EXPECT

You may get pockets of air or clear, yellow fluid under your PermeaDerm. If you have only a few pockets of air or fluid, you can:

1. Clean small scissors with alcohol.
2. Make a tiny cut in the PermeaDerm.
3. Roll out air/fluid with cotton tip applicator.

If fluid continues to develop under your PermeaDerm, or if the pockets of fluid are green, tan, creamy, thick or smell, call us, as you may need to be re-evaluated sooner.

### OTHER INSTRUCTIONS

**Children:** Wrap with dry gauze daily to protect. Do not get PermeaDerm wet. Call if pockets of fluid continue to accumulate under PermeaDerm.

**Adults:** Leave dressings off during the day. Use a dry wrap at night. Do not get PermeaDerm wet.

### CALL YOUR SURGEON'S OFFICE IF:

- + Temperature of 101.5° or higher.
- + Fluid that is green, tan, creamy, thick or smells.
- + Redness spreading out from around the edges of the burn.
- + Worsening/increasing pain.



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
